- 6. Road Traffic Insurance requirements.

This cover will provide Competitors who need to use the scheme with Third Party Cover necessary to meet Road Traffic Act (RTA) Insurance Scheme on the Road sections of the Event only. The basic rate is £35 for the day. (before any loadings i.e. if unable to comply) (This cover is NOT included in the entry fee).

Vehicles must have a valid motor insurance policy which provides as a minimum, Third Party Liability cover that complies with the Road Traffic Act. This can be either, by extending an existing motor policy to cover the event, or, by purchasing additional cover, providing under the Event Road Section Scheme as an adjunct to an existing motor policy. If a competitor has an extension to their existing policy, they will be required to sign a declaration that the cover complies with the requirements of the Road Traffic Act. Any responsibility for a fraudulent or misleading declaration about existing cover lies with the competitor.

If a competitor wishes to purchase additional Road Section cover via the organisers then they can do so prior to the event providing they comply with the following:

- is aged 19 years or older
- has held a full UK / EU driving license for a minimum of 6 months

- has no more than 6 conviction points on their license and no bans of any kind
- has had no more than 1 fault claim in the last 3 years
- do not have the Third-Party Extension cover on their existing motor policy
- the vehicle has a valid MOT and taxed for the road, unless exempt from doing so

Anyone aged less than 19 years old will also be accepted at the same price should their co-driver be a more senior member of their family or over 25. Any competitor who falls outside these parameters may be offered cover at equivalent terms or an agreed price, if approval from the Appointed Insurance Broker has been obtained by the event organisers, prior to the event. Approval can be sought by Event Organisers sending an email to the <u>contact@reis.co.uk</u> and provide the Drivers' name and date of birth, the date they passed their driving test and full details of any motoring claims and/or convictions.

Additional cover provided by this scheme is only effective whilst the vehicle is actively competing in the event and remains under the control or direction of the event organiser(s). Cover will cease immediately if you are precluded, excluded or retire from the event.

8. Reconnaissance & Admin checks

The schedule for the reconnaissance will be published in the supplementary regulations.

During reconnaissance there will be two stickers issued. A windscreen sticker must be displayed one on the top left corner of the windscreen of the car and one on the rear window. Failure to do so will be deemed to be a breach of the reconnaissance regulations

If any competitor drives on a Special Stage in a manner liable to cause distress, in the opinion of the Clerk of the Course, to an official of the event, to a resident of the Special Stage, to other road users, or to the Police, then this will be deemed to be a breach of the reconnaissance regulations. Any competitor deemed to be in breach of reconnaissance regulations will be reported to the Stewards where the penalties imposed may be

start refused and/or a fine and/or disqualification and reported to the competitor's ASN. Any Competitor disqualified on this basis will not be granted a refund of the entry fee. 9. Service Park

The Service Park for the event will be in Magherafelt. A plan of the Service Park will be included in the Sportity app.

On arrival at the Service Park, all service crews must report to the Service Park Manager.

All service crews must use a ground sheet.

The Rally HQ is located in the scrutiny building in the Service Park.

A service area overview video will be available on the Magherafelt Motorclub website and sportity app.

10. Refuelling.

Refuelling will be allowed in the service area. Refuelling is via self-refuel Refuelling is ONLY permitted once - at Service A Each crew must have their own Fire Extinguisher, which must be placed outside of the service vehicle and be available for use at all times.
